

Motor Vehicle Accidents

Following your initial assessment, a Treatment Plan will be submitted to your Auto Insurer. According to Ontario Law, your Extended Health Coverage (if available) will initially be billed for your care. You will be given an invoice to submit to your Extended Health Coverage Insurer. When/if these benefits are exhausted, the Auto Insurer will be billed directly for services rendered.

An **Application for Accident Benefits form (OCF-1)** must be submitted by you to your Auto Insurance Company. You may be required to make payment for care if the OCF-1 is not submitted.

Work Related Injuries Claims through the Worker's Safety and Insurance Board WSIB

WSIB will be billed directly for your care. It is your responsibility to ensure the following information has been completed. A **Worker's Report** Injury Form (Form 6) must be completed by you and submitted to WSIB as soon as possible. Your employer is required to complete an **Employer's Report** (Form 7).

Claims are not automatically approved. If your claim is not accepted by WSIB or you fail to meet the minimum number of required appointments set forward by WSIB, you will be required to make payment for care either Privately or through your Extended Health Coverage.
